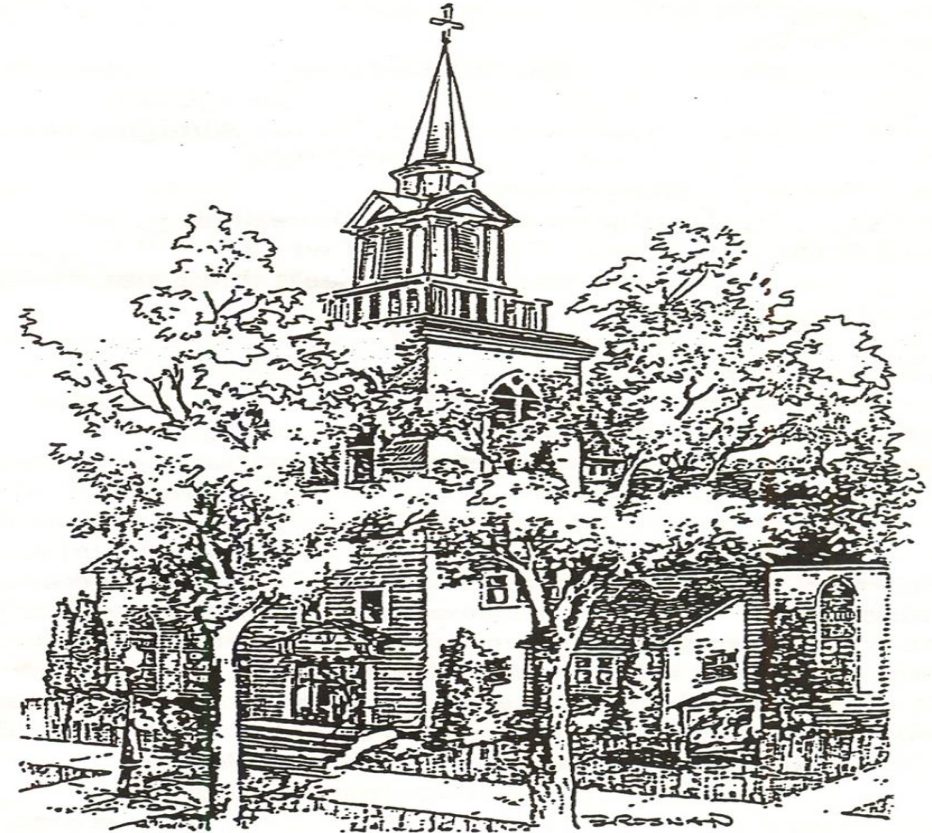
Today we will be taking the donation for the Sundance meal.
